ALMA COLLEGE



Todd Hibbs was named the new wrestling coach at Alma College in February 2011. Hibbs was Head Coach at Olivet from 2004-08, rebuilding an eliminated program to a top-10 team nationally. His team also ranked second academically in NCAA Division III (97 schools)



Jeremiah Tobias is a graduate of Manchester High School (2000) where he was a scholar athlete and four-time state champion in wrestling. He earned the Dave Schultz Excellence Award for the state of Michigan in 2000 as well, a national award taking into account excellence in wrestling, scholastic achievement, character, citizenship and community service. He continued his success at the University of Michigan where he was a three-year letter winner. During his time as a Wolverine, he was the champion of various college tournaments including the Michigan State Open, Eastern Michigan Open and Cleveland State Open. Tobias also holds the career pin record with 57 total.

EASTERN MICHIGAN



Derek DelPorto grew up in Erie, Pa. and graduated from Cathedral Prep of Erie in 1994. DelPorto went on to wrestle as a collegian at Slippery Rock where he recorded the third-best record in school history at 116-38 in his four seasons. He earned NCAA All-American honors in 1999 in the heavyweight classification at the NCAA Division I championship. He was also a three-time East Regional champion, winning the heavyweight titles in 1998 and 1999 and capturing the 177 lbs. crown in 1996. DelPorto also won the PSAC heavyweight title in 1998.

4x Michigan State letter-winner. Head coach of Team Shamrock and NXT LVL wrestling academy. Team Shamrock is a 2x state champs and 2x state runner up. Regarded as one of the best youth coaches in the country. Hold clinics and camps throughout the nation all year known for high energy and positive style of coaching.

Daron Cruickshank is an American lightweight fighter currently signed to the UFC. He is a black belt in Tae Kwon Do and trains under his father at Michigan Top Team in Detroit, Michigan. He was also a NCAA Division III wrestler while he earned a bachelors degree in Fitness Management from Olivet College. He made his amateur MMA debut in 2008. He turned professional in 2009.

- Rules:** Modified High School Rules, 3 periods, each being one and one half minutes in length with a running clock. Wrestlers start neutral at the start of each period. They also start neutral anytime they go out of bounds.
- Awards:** First place medals each week
- Entry Fee:** \$450 per team (Max. 12 wrestlers) or \$75 per wrestler. Fee includes all 6 dates including the clinics. Schools may enter more than one team. Please make check payable to **Milan Wrestling Booster Club**.
